這個主日的福音是耶穌「生命之糧」言論的第二段(若六41-51)。

由於耶穌說祂是 從天上降下來的食糧」,猶太人因此而對耶穌竊竊私議。舊約常常出現以色列子民竊竊私議的情況,尤其是他們在曠野流徙的時代中最為常見,舊約的作者用這種方式表達以色列子民不相信天主、或祂所派遣來的先知。由此看出,這裡群眾竊竊私議的態度,顯示他們不相信耶穌的話。

天主的訓誨。』」根據這句先知書上的話,一切人都要被稱做天主的學生。先知們的預言現在已經實現了,因為人們可以聽見耶穌的話,是一個和耶穌基督密不可分、而且對一切人開放的內關係、直接的關係,其必須經不可分的關係、直接的關係,其必須經由祂而得到教導。聆聽耶穌,就是直接蒙受「天主的訓誨」,而「由父聽教而學習的,必到耶穌這裡來。」

這段經文的最後(47-51)再次提起 前面已經出現過的主題,首先是耶 穌再次要求眾人必須相信,說明出 於自由的信仰是得到永生的決定性 因素:「我實實在在告訴你們:信 從的人必得永生。」耶穌並且再次指 出「瑪納」和真實的「天上食糧」之 間絕對的不同:瑪納屬於「世上」的 層面,不能夠救人脫離死亡;耶穌 屬於「天上」的層面,祂才是使人得 到永遠生命的食糧。祂說:「我是從 天上降下的生活的食糧。」整段談話 的重心特別表現在「生命」和「死亡 兩個極端不同的對立思想: 誰如果 吃了天上降下的生活的食糧,就是 說誰若相信耶穌,就必定要生活直 到永遠,他將不會見到死亡。

聖莫尼加堂130週年彌撒(英粵雙語)主禮:巴拉瑪打教區阮文龍主教

本主的的答唱詠選自聖詠第34篇。

原文標明是達味所作,寫此詩的背景是在他作撒烏耳君王的臣子時,撒烏耳因嫉妒而追殺他;達味因此逃走,更要在人前裝瘋扮傻才得以保命(見撒上21:11-15)。全詩共二十二節,每節起首均以希伯來語的字母順序排列,這種體裁除了顯出詩人的才情,更是為方便記憶和背誦。全詩的內容都是讚頌眷顧人的天主。

答句出自第9節(請你們體驗,請你們觀看:上主是何等的和藹慈善!投奔他的必獲真福永歡),聖奧斯定和聖多瑪斯都註釋人應「體驗」和「觀看」的,是上主賜下的真正食糧:基督聖體聖血;領受者必獲上主的真福。

第2和3節(我必要時時讚美上主,對他的讚頌常在我口;願我的心靈因上主而自豪,願謙卑的人聽到也都喜躍),詩人邀請大眾,無論在順境和逆景,都應讚頌天主。

第4至5節(請你們同我一起讚揚上主,讓我們齊聲頌揚他的名字。我尋求了上主,他聽了我的祈求:由我受的一切驚惶中,將我救出),詩人再次邀請眾人齊聲頌揚天主,含蓄地預示新約才出現的大公教會,即由萬民因天主呼召而成的「基督的奧體」;因著主的創造、救贖和聖化而共融合一。

第6至7節(你們瞻仰他,要喜形於色,你們的面容,絕不會羞愧。卑微人一呼號,上主立即俯允,並且救拔他出離一切的苦辛),達味寫出自己的經驗。他屢次化險為夷,完全來自上主的慈愛和救助(詳見撒上18至21章)。

第8節(在那敬畏上主的人四周,有上主的天使紮營護守),「天使紮營護守」一句,來自以色列人相信上主派遣祂的天使,看守著「約櫃」,再泛指上主派遣天使去保護遵守盟約的天主子民。教會按這句和出23:20(看!我在你面前派遣我的使者,為在路上保護你,領你到我所準備的地方),詠91:11(因為他必為你委派自己的天使,在你行走的每條道路上保護你),認定天主為眷顧人創造並賜給人「護守天使」。

SOAP Reflection 11th August

Scripture- John 6:41-51

Observation- This passage accentuates the significance of faith as a gift, but in order to execute this belief we must require certain dispositions of the heart. Jesus' claims are considered controversial or inconceivable-the notion of only performing good deeds is not enough; that Jesus has come down from heaven and those who believe in Christ will receive eternal life. In response, the Jews grumble and mutter-mimicking the behaviour of the Israelites throughout their journey to the Promised Land. However, if we remember from this story, the manna was not enough (as Jesus says in verse 49: "Your ancestors ate the manna in the wildnerness, yet they died.") and the Israelites continued to sin. They were seeking material comfort and satisfaction, rather than the eternal hope and joy which comes from following Christ. This passage reminds us of the truth- that Jesus is the Bread of Life, and only through faith in the Eucharist are we able to enter into a new life much holier and larger than the materialistic and superficial confines of our modern world.

Application- We may often unknowingly (or knowingly) disregard Jesus and our beliefs in our daily lives- after all, God has given us the beautiful gift of free will and allows us to choose whether or not we want to listen and open our hearts. The Jews in today's gospel think they know Jesus- they grew up with Him, they know He is the son of Mary and Joseph, both of whom they are quite familiar with; but they did not know His heart, nor were they willing to listen with humility and acceptance. Similarly, we may consider whether we truly know and love Christ ourselves. Are we really listening to what God is saying to us, or are we ignoring Him? When we build this habit of discerning and being attentive to the movements of our hearts, we are able to simultaneously strengthen our faith and realise there is something greater beyond the world we live in, and our very existence. Even those striving for material wealth, fame and success will ultimately arrive at a destination that is hollow and unfulfilling until they learn to put their trust in Jesus and the fact that he is the Bread of Life made to sustain us. As the Catholic hymn "I am the Bread of Life, He who comes to me shall not hunger; he who believes in me shall not thirst'.

Prayer- Dear Lord, thank you for sacrificing your only son Jesus down to this earth for us. I would like to pray for wisdom and faith to truly believe you are the Bread of Life, and you will provide for me in every aspect. Help me to realise my desires for wealth, fame, recognition or any materialistic ideal will never make me satisfied or fulfilled- for these things are temporary, but you and your love are eternal and everlasting. Jesus, you are all I ever need- as I consume the Eucharist, remind me that this is your body which has been given up for me, and I know this is the truth. Father, I believe in you, your infinite goodness and mercy. Thank you for always trying to guide me on the path to eternal life. I pray that I keep on this journey that you have paved for me out of the love I have for you and all that I do. Amen.
