野台導讀

這個主日的福音是延續上個主日的福音,耶穌在路上繼續教導門徒。這一段看起來連續的經文,其實含有許多關於基督徒愛德的教導:第一個教導由一個具體情況所引出,耶穌教導門徒團體如何面對團體以外的人(38-40);其次談到關心基督徒的人,必有其賞報(41);最後一段經文內容則是要求門徒要善待團體中的弱小者(42-50)。

門徒們發現,在門徒團體之外也有人仗著耶穌的名字驅魔,他們禁止了這個人,因為他並未加入門徒團體。若望並且理直氣壯地向耶穌報告了一切,言下之意似乎認為這人既然是一個局外人,怎麼也可以得到如此重要的權柄和地位。

福音中的這個情況在今日的生活脈絡中,也屢見不鮮。我們可以在今日的情境中重新描述若望的問題:我們該如何看待那些呼求基督名號、自稱是基督徒,卻不加入、甚至否定「教會」的團體或個人?

歸屬於耶穌團體的人,不可以排斥或否認在團體之外所有的善行好事。真理遠超過人的智慧和思想,沒有一個人或一個團體能明白全部的真理,基督徒團體的成員尤其要對真理開放。

一個真正跟隨耶穌的團體,其 最根本的生命基礎在於對天主 的熱情,具體的表現則在於關懷 和協助團體中的弱小成員。充滿 友愛的團體是天國最佳的見證, 而唯有天國才是值得人們犧牲 一切,不計代價去追求的永恆目 標。

本主日答唱詠選自聖詠第19篇。

原文標明是達味所作,全詩分前、後兩個部分。前半部分(第1-7節)是讚美創造萬有的天主,後半部分(第8-15節)是頌揚救世的天主。聖經學者大都接受兩部分其實一氣呵成。本日答唱詠讀出的屬後半部分。

第8至10節(上主的法律是完善的,能暢快人靈;上主的約章是忠誠的,能開啟愚蒙;上主的規誠是正直的,能悅樂心情;上主的命令是光明的,能燭照眼睛;上主的訓誨是純潔的,永遠常存;上主的判斷是真實的上無不公允)是達味讚美上主法律的完備,句式相當齊整,是為方便誦讀(或詠唱)和記憶。內容基本上是申4:6(你們要謹守遵行,因為這樣,在萬民眼中,纔能屬出你們的智慧和見識;他們一聽到這一切法令說:『這和你們的智慧和見識;他們一聽到這一切法令說:『也和吳一個有智慧,有見識的大民族!』)的伸延,也和另一首較晚寫成的聖詠(詠119,亦是讚頌上主法律的聖詠,最遲寫於瑪加伯時代),相當吻合。

第11節(比黃金,比極純的黃金更可愛戀;比蜂蜜,比蜂巢的流汁更要甘甜),作者用黃金和蜂蜜跟上主的法律比較。黃金是富有的人所渴望擁有的財富,由蜂窩流出來的蜂蜜是在曠野旅居,忍饑受餓,一無所有的人的渴望;而上主法律的價值和珍貴,都遠遠超於黃金和蜂密。

第12至14節(你僕人雖留心這一切,竭盡全力遵守這一切,但誰能認出自己的一切過犯?求你赦免我未覺察到的罪愆。更求你使你僕人免於自負,求你不要讓驕傲把我佔有;如此我將成為完人,重大罪惡免污我身),指的是人藉天主的法律反省,明認罪過,追求德行,邁向純全。耶穌基督的訓誨也是如此。

SOAP Reflection 29th September

Scripture: Mark 9: 38-43, 45, 47-48

Observation

In this passage, we witness Jesus' teachings on the seriousness of sin and how we should deal with anything that causes us/others to stumble. Initially, Jesus encounters a situation where John reports someone casting out demons in Jesus' name, in which he emphasises how "whoever is not against us is for us." This continues into his warnings against His disciples about the consequences of causing others to 'stumble,' metaphorically stating how one should cut off their hands/feet and pluck their eyes to signify the importance of removing anything that leads to sin. Jesus finishes by stating how it is beneficial, as Catholics, to remove all sin by any means possible to lead a life into God's kingdom, than to allow sin to persist and face eternal punishment in hell.

Application

As Catholics, we are called to reflect on the seriousness of sins in our lives and the impact our actions can have on others. Jesus' warning to remove anything that causes sin, even at great personal cost, reminds us to examine our lives and remove habits, behaviours, and influences that lead us or others away from God. This passage challenges us with integrity, to take sin seriously, and to act in a way that upholds and nurtures the faith of others.

Prayer

Dear God,

Thank you for the unconditional love and mercy You show us each day. As we reflect on your teachings, we pray to take sin seriously and to have the courage to remove anything that may lead us astray. Give us the strength to make the sacrifices necessary to follow You wholeheartedly, knowing that eternal life with You is far more precious than earthly comfort.

Entrance Antiphon

FIRST READING NUMBERS 11:25-29

The Lord came down in the Cloud. He spoke with Moses, but took some of the spirit that was on him and put it on the seventy elders. When the spirit came on them they prophesied, but not again.

Two men had stayed back in the camp; one was called Eldad and the other Medad. The spirit came down on them; though they had not gone to the Tent, their names were enrolled among the rest. These began to prophesy in the camp. The young man ran to tell this to Moses, 'Look', he said, 'Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp.' 
3. So in them your servant finds instructions; great reward is in their keeping. But who can detect all his errors? From hidden faults acquit me. (R.)

SECOND READING ST JAMES 5:1-6

An answer for the rich. Start crying, weep for the miseries that are coming to you. Your wealth is all rotting, your clothes are all eaten up by moths. All your gold and your silver are corroding away, and the same corrosion will be your own sentence, and eat into your body. It was a burning fire that you stored up as your treasure for the last days. Labourers mowed your fields, and you cheated them - listen to the wages that you kept back, calling out; realise that the cries of the reapers have reached the ears of the Lord of hosts. On earth you have had a life of comfort and luxury; in the time of slaughter you went on eating to your heart's content. It was you who condemned the innocent and killed them; they offered you no resistance.

GOSPEL MARK 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

John said to Jesus, 'Master, we saw a man who is not one of us casting out devils in your name; and because he was not one of us we tried to stop him.' But Jesus said, 'You must not stop him: no one who works a miracle in my name is likely to speak evil of me. Anyone who is not against us is for us.

'If anyone gives you a cup of water to drink just because you belong to Christ, then I tell you solemnly, he will most certainly not lose his reward.

'But anyone who is an obstacle to bring down one of these little ones who have faith, would be better thrown into the sea with a great millstone round his neck. And if your hand should cause you to sin, cut it off; it is better for you to enter into life crippled, than to have two hands and go to hell, into the fire that cannot be put out. And if your foot should cause you to sin, cut it off; it is better for you to enter into life lame, than to have two feet and be thrown into hell. And if your eye should cause you to sin, tear it out; it is better for you to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than to have two eyes and be thrown into hell where their worm does not die nor their fire go out.
