# 福音 聖馬爾谷福音10:35-45

馬爾谷福音記載耶穌三次預言 自己將在耶路撒冷遭受苦難, 個主日的福音敘述耶穌第三次所 們徒預告(谷十32-34)之後 生的一個事件,以及耶穌相 等已在谷九33-37出現過,核 對實已在谷九33-37出現過,核 过 問題是「門徒們在天國中的 完自己的苦難之後,門徒之 罰發生爭奪高位的糾紛, 題出他 們根本沒有了解耶穌的話。

整段敘述分成兩段,首先是載伯德的兩個兒子和耶穌之間的談話,他們要求在天國中佔有最高的地位,耶穌針對這個要求給予教導(35-40)。這段經文引出第二段的敘述:雅各伯和若望的要知。無不可提們另一段相稱的教導(40-45)。這個教導就是這段經文真正的主題,也就是關於教會團體的管理、統治和服務等主題。

雅各伯和若望的行動使另外十 位門徒憤怒,這個情況促使耶穌 繼續教導他們團體的生活規則。 耶穌首先提出一個消極圖像,指 出世間的統治者是藉著壓迫以及 濫用權 力來管理人民,門徒團體 當中卻不應該如此。在門徒團體 中,同樣的也有人佔有高位和權 力,但是相對於其他的人,他們應 該執行僕人般的服務,他們應該 實踐的規則只有一條,就是耶穌 自己一再教導的、並且以身作則 實現的生活方式。門徒團體的生 活規則就是耶穌的生活榜樣:祂 「不是來受服事,而是來服事人」 (45) 。

最後,耶穌說明祂的服事是沒有限度的,直到祂「把自己的生命交出」;然而,祂的死亡本身並非目的,而是「做為大眾的贖價」(45)。這句話超越了耶穌三次 的苦難預言(33),說明了祂死亡的意義。

本主日讀經的答唱詠選自聖詠33篇。

希伯來文原文沒有標明誰是作者。天主教會按 最古舊的譯本註釋為達味君王所作。按內容, 可能是達味戰勝異民後(見撒下8:1-14)讚頌 天主的詩歌。

答句選自第22節(上主,求你向我們廣施慈愛,有如我們對你所存的期待),是回應讀經一(依53:10-11),亦即是「受苦僕人之歌」。天主會派遣救主(就是那位受苦的僕人)給期待祂救援的人民。

第4至5節(因為上主的言語是正直的,他的一切作為都是忠實的;他愛護正義和公理,他的慈愛瀰漫大地),說明天主以率真、誠實、公正與慈愛厚待全人類。

第18至21節(請看,上主的眼睛常關注敬畏他的人,他的雙目常眷顧靠他仁慈的人,為使他們的性命,脫免死亡,使他們在饑饉時,生活如常。我們的靈魂仰望著上主,他是我們的惡魂仰望著上主,他是我們的保障和扶助;我們的心靈要因他而喜樂歡暢,在他的聖名內寄托我們的希望。),聖奧斯定註釋說:今世的時刻是饑餓的,來日才是飽飫的喜晨。地上涕泣之谷的人,天主已這樣恩待;來世在天主的國,天主的愛更有過之。因此人應在現世時敬畏、欽崇和孝愛天主,仰賴祂的慈愛;世界窮盡、新天新地時,天主必廣施祂無限的慈恩。

Scripture: Mark 10:35-45

#### **Observation:**

When we read the Gospel today, we may get caught up in the seeming arrogance of James and John but this week's Gospel highlights two important elements of discipleship.

When James and John asked Jesus to let them sit at His right and left hand respectively, they may not have been doing so out of selfishness or arrogance but simply because they wanted to demonstrate their loyalty and willingness to submit to God.

Jesus alludes to his suffering and death when he asks James and John whether they'd be able to drink the same cup he drinks to which the brothers state that they can. They proved that these were not just empty words said at the moment, and demonstrated their loyalty and commitment to God. James was the first of the disciples to be martyred and John was sent into exile. James and John highlighted a key part of discipleship in their ability to submit themselves to God's will. In the second part of the Gospel, the idea of servitude is highlighted. Jesus states that to follow him, the disciples must first have a heart of servitude. He told them that even He, the son of man, came to Earth to serve, and give his life.

#### **Application:**

Often in life, we crave a sense of control. We often have an idea or a plan of how we want things to go- whether that be in our relationships, in our careers, in exams and tests and even down to each nitty-gritty decision in our lives. But sometimes, we need to take a step back and not get so caught up on these grand plans we have made for ourselves and learn to submit to God's plan. It may not be what we had in mind, but it will be so much better than we could've planned.

In today's world where society is so obsessed with the idea of "self", it is hard to see how servitude can eventually come around and allow you to put others first. However, Jesus teaches us that even He came to the world to serve. So if even God himself lived to serve us, with what reason do we have to put ourselves above everyone else or above God?

#### Prayer

Lord, let not my will but Yours be done and show me how to live a life of true discipleship and servitude.

## GOSPEL MARK 10:35-45

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, approached Jesus. 'Master,' they said to him, 'we want you to do us a favour.' He said to them, 'What is it you want me to do for you?' They said to him, 'Allow us to sit one at your right hand and the other at your left in your glory.' 'You do not know what you are asking' Jesus said to them. 'Can you drink the cup that I must drink, or be baptised with the baptism with which I must be baptised?' They replied, 'We can.' Jesus said to them, 'The cup that I must drink you shall drink,

and with the baptism with which I must be baptised you shall be baptised, but as for seats at my right hand or my left, these are not mine to grant; they belong to those to whom they have been allotted.'

When the other ten heard this they began to feel indignant with James and John, so Jesus called them to him and said to them: 'You know that among the pagans their so-called rulers lord it over them, and their great men make their authority felt. This is not to happen among you. No; anyone who wants to become great among you must be your servant, and anyone who wants to be first among you must be slave to all.
